Wider Curriculum

- We will look at forming letters correctly to begin to develop a handwriting style. We will use scissors to cut out simple shapes. We will develop skills including throwing, catching, kicking and aiming.
- We will retell stories, use new vocabulary throughout the day and listen carefully.
- We will explore different artistic effects. We will develop storylines in our play. We will sing and dance in a group.
- We will think about our feelings and the feelings of others. We will show perseverance in problem solving.
- We will think about images form the past. We will draw simple maps. We will think about environments that are different to ours.
- We will recognise that people have different beliefs and celebrations.
- We will explore the natural world and look at the changing seasons.

How to support your child at home

Reading and homework expectations:

- Read every night with your child, encouraging them to read aloud.
- Sign your child's reading record at least once a week.
- Send your child's book into school every Monday to be changed.
- Phonics homework will be sent home every Monday

- Talk to your child about what they have done and what they have enjoyed using the daily class dojo posts.
- Encourage your child to dress independently in the mornings. Encourage them to zip up their own coat (especially the longer coats!)
