Focus on Attendance

This week's focus is: 'Roles and Responsibilities for Securing Excellent Attendance' We all have a role to play in securing attendance at school. The expectation on parents/carers are set out below. You:

- Have a legal duty to ensure that your child of compulsory school age attends school regularly.
- Must inform school straight away if your child cannot attend and give the reason.















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- Must make every effort to make medical, dental or other appointments outside the school day.
- Must ensure school is aware of any circumstances at home that may be likely to affect your child's attendance.
- Should encourage good routines at home which promote a healthy lifestyle including enough sleep.
- Should talk to your child about school and let school know if your child is worried about any issues such as difficulties with homework or friendship problems.
- Must ensure holidays are not booked in term time – these will only be authorised in exceptional circumstances.
- Should seek advice from their G.P. if you are unsure how long your child will be off school with an illness and provide medical evidence to support absence if requested to do so by the school.
- Must ensure school has up-to-date contact details.
- Should encourage your child to enjoy school and make the most of all the opportunities available to them.
